

GWP Appoints Alan Hall as Senior Advisor

After four years at the GWP secretariat in Stockholm, Alan Hall is leaving his position as Coordinator of Global Initiatives, but will continue as a Senior Advisor working from the U.K.

He has participated in numerous task forces, most recently in the Scientific Programme Committee (SPC) for the World Water Week, and as a co-writer of the latest GWP TEC Paper on *Water Financing and Governance* (TEC Paper 12).
